#### Surgeries will be closed on festive bank holidays

Please note that both surgeries will be closed over the bank holidays. So the patient group advice is to ensure you have all the medication you need for the extended weekends before the holidays.

Christmas means Monday December 26, and Tuesday December 27. The following week Monday January 2 will be also be a full closure.

Emergency cover will be provided by the 111 Service. Please ring 111 and note that when you receive treatment from this service or at the walk-in centre, a clinical report will be sent to the surgeries to update your medical record and ensure that any necessary follow-up action can be arranged.

There is also the walk-in centre based at the North Colchester Healthcare Centre, Primary Care Centre, Turner Road, Colchester CO4 5JR, where you may see the nurse for:

- Wounds (cuts, minor burns)
- Muscle and joint injuries (strains, sprains, back pain)
- Coughs, colds, flu symptoms
- Stomach-ache, indigestion, constipation
- Sore throats, earache
- Skin complaints (rashes, minor allergic reactions, scabies)
- Sexual health and emergency contraception services.

Note: repeat prescriptions are NOT available. Please make sure you have enough
