When to refer to podiatry:

- Foot ulceration
- In-growing toenails
- Heel pain workshop for heel pain/ plantar fasciitis
- Biomechanical problems (foot and leg pain)
- Diabetics with risk factors and foot pathology e.g. Neuropathy/vascular disease/ deformity
- Immuno-suppression with foot pathology  
Peripheral Vascular disease or neuropathy with foot pathology.

Please be aware we **do not** offer a service for:

- Minor foot problems or basic foot care (Such as corns and callus) in otherwise healthy individuals.
- Minor foot problems in patients with osteo-arthritis or joint replacement in the absence of other significant factors
- Routine or basic nail care. The department only provides treatment for patients with pathological nails such as grossly thickened/ingrowing nails for surgery.
- Low Risk Diabetics or diabetic patients requiring basic nail care.
- Verruca's
- Fungal infections (nails and skin)

Please note, we can not accept referrals for children under age of 16 via the self-referral portal.
